Listening task 4 (Recordings '3 Customer with donation/worksheet 7)

- 1. The customer wants to give things to the shop.
- 2. The following items are in the bag:

Photo albums	[]

(There aren't any photo albums- the customer is going to bring them later.)

3. Yes, the customer decides to join Gift Aid.

Listening task 5 (Recordings '3 Customer with donation/worksheet 8)

- 1. But we can, if you like, send them for recycling.
- You might not want to have it <u>recycled</u>.
- 3. It depends on whether they've got anybody who can test electrical items.
- 4. We're not allowed to sell them.
- 5. Do you know about the Gift Aid scheme?
- 6. My colleague over there will help you.

- 1. Take it home if it can be used.
- 2. They don't have anybody who can test electrical items.
- 3. Yes, if they're in good condition.
- 4. 28%
- 5. No, she says her colleague will help.
